<b>ACORUS gramineus 'Ogon'</b> Bright yellow foliage needs moisture and feeding.		9"	£5.50
<b>ANEMANTHELE Lessoniana</b> Evergreen arching foliage which turns bronze with age. The flowers are soft brown and trailing.	<b>AGM</b>	3'	£5.70
<b>BRIZA media 'Limouzi'</b> This form has greyer foliage and large flowers heads. Will grow even in poorly drained areas.		15"	£5.60
<b>CALAMAGROSTIS x acutiflora 'Overdam'</b> White striped foliage in a very upright grass.		3'	£5.80
<b>CAREX comans 'Bronze Form'</b> Mops of narrow arching leaves the colour of milk chocolate. We shall also have a form with darker brown foliage without the chestnut colouring.		16"	£5.50
<b>CAREX comans 'Frosted Curls'</b> Pale green arching leaves with silvery curling tips.		18"	£5.50
<b>CAREX elata 'Aurea'</b> (Bowles' Golden Sedge) Bright yellow foliage. Needs moisture and is slow to establish.	<b>AGM</b>	2'	£5.60
<b>CAREX flacca subsp. flacca</b> Good grey evergreen.		1'	£5.50
<b>CAREX morrowii 'Variegata'</b> Evergreen leaves with a slightly white edge makes an elegant clump.		16"	£5.60
<b>CAREX oshimensis 'Evergold'</b> Evergreen sedge. Curling yellow foliage with green margins.	<b>AGM</b>	9"	£5.60
<b>CAREX pendula</b> Strong growing, evergreen, arching stems. Good in shade in the wild garden. Large plants.		3'	£5.60
<b>CAREX siderosticha 'Variegata'</b> Wide leaves edged with white, creeping but slowly. Needs well drained conditions or a sunnier site than most sedges.		16"	£5.60

<b>CAREX ‘Silver Sceptre’</b>	6"	£5.50
Makes an excellent dense carpet of white striped leaves. Evergreen.		
<b>CAREX tenuiculmis</b>	18"	£5.50
Light brown with an arching habit. Flowers in mid-summer.		
<b>CAREX trifida ‘Rekohu Sunrise’</b>	18"	£5.90
Evergreen arching leaves edged with cream, occasionally striped. Not wet conditions.		
<b>CYPERUS eragrostis</b>	18"	£5.60
Evergreen sedge with interesting clusters of pale green spikelets in late summer.		
<b>CYPERUS longus</b>	18"	£5.60
Elegant upright plant with globular heads of brown. Very attractive all year.		
<b>DESCHAMPSIA flexuosa ‘Tatra Gold’</b>	16"	£5.50
Tufts of yellowish-green all year. Grows best in fertile soil with some shade.		
<b>ELYMUS magellanicus</b>	2'	£5.70
An excellent evergreen grey grass. A clump forming couch grass.		
<b>FESTUCA glauca ‘Elijah Blue’</b>	1'	£5.60
Evergreen clumps of glaucous blue.		
<b>HAKONECHLOA macra ‘Aureola’</b>	<b>AGM</b> 1'	£5.70
Good yellow variegation on the narrow arching foliage of this grass. Needs good fertile soil.		
<b>HAKONECHLOA macra ‘Nicolas’</b>	1'	£5.70
Orange and green foliage which deepens through the summer. Deciduous. <b>PBR</b>		
<b>HELICTOTRICHON sempervirens ‘Saphirsprudel’</b>	2'6"	£5.80
Excellent spikey blue-grey grass. Needs sun and good drainage and is an evergreen.		
<b>HOLCUS mollis ‘Albo-variegatus’</b>	6"	£5.50
Dwarf variegated grass. Increases steadily.		
<b>IMPERATA cylindrica ‘Red Baron’</b>	18"	£5.70
The Japanese blood grass. Rich red leaves. Needs fertile soil and sun.		

<b>JUNCUS effusus ‘Carman’s Japanese’</b>		18”	£5.60
Makes a clump of upright steely grey foliage. Evergreen.			
<b>JUNCUS ensifolius</b>		16”	£5.60
A small rush with brown globular heads and small Iris like foliage.			
<b>LUZULA maxima ‘Marginata’</b>		18”	£5.50
Woodrush. Dense clumps of green leaves edged with white. Evergreen.			
<b>LUZULA nivea</b>		1’	£5.70
Excellent small rush for shade. Dark green foliage, masses of white flowers.			
<b>LUZULA sylvatica ‘Aurea’</b>		1’	£5.80
Broad evergreen leaves, golden yellow. Best in fertile conditions.			
<b>MILLIUM effusum aureum</b>	<b>AGM</b>	2’	£5.50
(‘Bowles’ Golden Grass’) Gold to yellow green, soft textured leaves. Tufted clump.			
<b>MISCANTHUS ‘Cabaret’</b>		4’6”	£7.00
Wide leaves with creamy white centre. Sunny, dry conditions.			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Kleine Fontane’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	4’	£7.00
Narrow green leaves with a stripe up the middle. The flowers open silvery red in August and fade to silver.			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Malepartus’</b>		5’	£7.00
Broad foliage, silver striped, flower heads of deepest purplish red fading to silver. <b>NEW</b>			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Morning Light’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	3’	£7.00
Very graceful narrow foliage edged with white. Makes an elegant clump.			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Silberfeder’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	6’	£7.00
Tall stems carry silky plumes of beige. Beautiful in autumn.			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Yakushima Dwarf’</b>		2’	£7.00
A dwarf, clump forming selection. The panicles appear in late October. An excellent form, lovely in a large pot.			
<b>MISCANTHUS sinensis ‘Zebrinus’</b>	<b>AGM</b>	4’	£7.00
Green leaves with bands of gold.			

<b>MOLINIA caerulea 'Moorhexe'</b>		18"	£5.70
From a tight clump of upright green foliage rises a narrow column topped with needle like flowers. Excellent in pots or as an accent plant.			
<b>MOLINIA caerulea 'Variegata'</b>	<b>AGM</b>	18"	£5.70
Herbaceous grass. Short tufts of green and cream leaves turning brown in autumn before disappearing.			
<b>ORYZOPSIS milliacea</b>		5'	£5.90
Bamboo grass. Graceful grass with fine willowy flower panicles. Cut down in spring.			
<b>PENNISETUM alopecuroides 'Red Head'</b>		1'6"	£6.20
Bottle brush heads open red and fade to beige. Early flowering. Needs sun and well-drained conditions. Deciduous, so can be cut back hard in the spring.			
<b>STIPA arundinacea</b>			
Now known as <b>ANEMANTHELE lessoniana</b>			
<b>STIPA gigantea</b>	<b>AGM</b>	4'	£5.90
A strong growing grass with huge heads of flowers turning a wonderful yellow in autumn.			
<b>STIPA tenuissima</b>		2'	£5.60
(Syn. S. tenuifolia) Pale brown fluffy plumes fading to white.			
<b>STIPA tenuissima 'Ponytails'</b>		2'	£5.60
Wispy pale green leaves topped with plumes of silver green.			
<b>UNCINIA rubra</b>		1'	£5.60
Evergreen low-growing red-leaved sedge. Sun for best colour.
